A study of art history might be a good way to learn more about the culture than is possible to learn in general history classes. Most typical history courses concentrate on politics, economics and war. But art history focuses on much more than this because art also reflects religious beliefs, emotions and psychology. In addition, information about the daily activities of our ancestors—or of people very different from our own—can be provided by art. In short, a study of art clearly offers us a deeper understanding than can be found in most history books.

History books usually present objective information about the political life of a country, but opinions are implicit. Art, on the other hand, is subjective: it reflects emotions and opinions. The great Spanish painter Francisco Goya was perhaps the first "political" artist. In his well-known painting The Third of May, 1808, he depicted soldiers shooting a group of simple people. This depiction of faceless soldiers and their victims has become a symbol of the enormous power—and the misuse of this power—that a government can have over its people. Over a hundred years later, the symbolic images in Pablo Picasso's Guernica express the horror of war. In summary, a personal and emotional view of history can be presented through art.

For centuries in Europe, religious art was almost the only type of art that existed. Churches and other religious buildings were filled with paintings that depicted people and stories from the Bible. Although most people were illiterate, they could still understand biblical stories in the pictures on church walls. By contrast, one of the main characteristics of art in the Middle East was (and still is) its absence of human and animal images. This reflects the Islamic belief (from the Koran) that statues are unholy. By Islamic law, artists are not allowed to copy human or animal figures except on small items for daily use (e.g. rugs and bowls). Thus, on palaces, mosques, and other buildings, Islamic artists have created unique decoration of great beauty with images of flowers and geometric forms. They have also shown great creativity and discipline in their use of Arabic writing as an art form.
